04 Eligibility Requirements

- have completed at least 12 years of formal education
- have studied Japanese before applying
- meet the Japanese language requirement for the course:
 - 24-Month College Prep Course: JLPT N5 or 150 hours of Japanese study
 - 18-Month College Prep Course: JLPT N4 or 300 hours of Japanese study
- be motivated to study in Japan and willing to continue studying seriously
- have a financial sponsor who can cover tuition and living expenses and provide proof of funds
- be physically and mentally fit to study and live in Japan
- be able to follow Japanese laws and school rules

05 Application Period

- April Admission: October to December of the previous year
- October Admission: April to June

06 Required Application Documents

Documents Related to the Applicant

- Application Form, Resume, and Statement of Purpose (school forms)
- 6 ID photos (4 cm × 3 cm, taken within the last 3 months)
- Certificate of final academic qualification (diploma or graduation certificate / certificate of expected graduation if currently enrolled)
- Academic transcript (for all academic years of the most recent school attended / certificate of enrollment if currently enrolled)
- Proof of Japanese language proficiency (certificate of Japanese study or Japanese language test certificate, such as JLPT or NAT-TEST)
- Copy of passport (if applicable)
- Copy of identification document
- Certificate of employment (if applicable)
- Birth certificate or family register documents
- Any other documents required by the school

Financial Sponsor Documents

- Letter of Financial Support (school form)
- Document proving the relationship with the applicant
- Bank balance certificate
- Documents proving the source and history of funds (such as past bank transaction records)
- Certificate of employment (business license or equivalent if self-employed)
- Income certificate and tax payment certificate

Notes: Original documents are required for non-reissuable documents such as diplomas. Reissuable certificates must be issued within the last 3 months. Documents in languages other than Japanese must be accompanied by a Japanese translation. Submitted documents will not be returned in principle.

07 Selection Process

- Document Screening
 - The applicant's academic background, Japanese language proficiency, purpose of study, and financial support capability will be comprehensively reviewed.
- Written Examination
 - A written examination will be conducted to assess the applicant's basic understanding and practical ability in Japanese.
- Interview (if necessary)
 - An interview may be conducted online or in person, if necessary, in order to assess the applicant's Japanese language ability, motivation to study, and communication skills.

08 Notification of Results

- The results will be notified to the applicant or the applicant's representative by email or in writing.

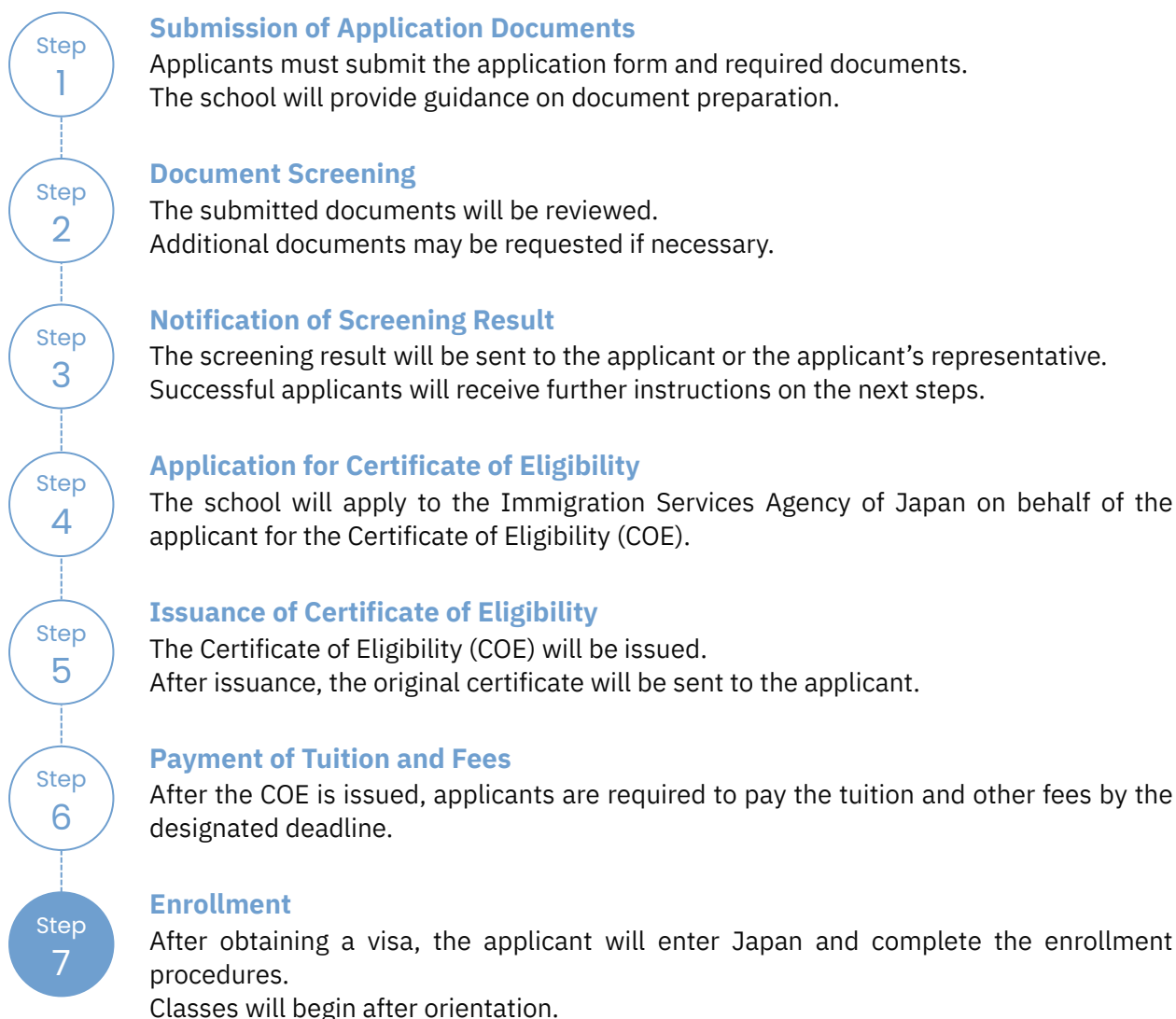
